

Message from the Pastor

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

How good it is for us to gather as a parish family, to celebrate our patronal feast day of Saint Joseph. This beautiful parish has been serving the people of Astoria for over 146 years! Founded by German immigrants it was built with the love and dedication of the people of God. Over the years the parish has seen many changes as all parishes do, but what remains constant is the love and dedication of the people of God. In my short time as Pastor, I have met so many good people that truly love their parish. We are blessed to have such a culturally diverse parish. On any given weekend we celebrate Mass in English, Spanish, and Italian. I see great signs of hope for our parish. Like the many young faces that come through our doors each weekend looking for Jesus. We are blessed with a robust religious education program, and a Catholic Academy. My vision for Saint Joseph's is that people find a loving community of believers centered on the Eucharist. We want people to feel like they belong when they come here. Evangelization Award: Delia Lili Chirinos

The Evangelization Award is for those parishioners who exemplify excellence in bringing other parishioners closer to the faith.

She started her life in the states living with her mother in Astoria, New York and working in a factory making light switches. It is there where she met her husband, Jesus Manuel Chirinos.

They were married in 1987 and welcomed their daughter, Annie, in 1988. Delia worked her whole adult life. After the factory she cared for the elderly and was a housekeeper. In the late nineties and early 2000s, she went to night school to earn her college degree. She graduated from Monroe College in 2001 with an almost perfect GPA score. After graduation, she started her career in the accounting field where she continues to work today.

Throughout her life she has always been involved with the church. She started her service at Most Precious Blood and subsequently came to St. Joseph's parish. Delia has served in many capacities: she is a Eucharist Minister; she teaches RCIA preparing adults to receive their sacraments; She has been instrumental in teaching English Language classes; She is a Virtus certified trainer; She is active in organizing fundraisers and church events; and she is the Leader of the Hispanic Pastoral Council. In 2022, Delia coordinated the Passion of Christ production. Most recently, she coordinated and lead a Bi-lingual Nativity production that brought Christmas cheer to our parishioners.

Delia has a "can-do" spirit that makes things happen. While she has accomplished many things in her life, she humbly will say that her greatest accomplishments are her 3 children and 4 grandchildren.

The Lectors of St. Joseph Parish serve the people by their proclamation of the Holy Scriptures at Mass during the week and on weekends. The Lectors receive training on how to properly proclaim the Word of God and have workbooks that they use to reflect on the Scriptures as they prepare during the week to read the Sunday or weekday Scriptures. They attend Days of Reflection that enhance and enrich their spiritual lives and help them develop a true love of Scripture. The ministry of Lectors is open to all fully initiated Catholics who are active in the parish.
