



Evangelization Award

Marlene Kaselis

The Evangelization Award is for those parishioners who exemplify excellence in bringing other parishioners closer to the faith.

Marlene was born in Binghamton, NY. At the age of seven she moved with her parents to Sunnyside, NY, where they lived for about 18 years. After graduating from Holy Cross Academy for Young Ladies in Manhattan (has since been demolished), it was time to seek employment.

After various positions she ended up in the world of sports marketing. Her first job in this genre was with the National Hockey League Services, the marketing end of the National Hockey League. It was here she learned to appreciate the game of hockey, as one of the benefits of the job was tickets to the Ranger games. After about 5 years she decided to leave the League and took a job with Capital Sports, where she stayed for about 30 years. During her tenure there she worked on a Tennis Challenge, Ski Challenge, Fun Run, 1980 Winter Olympics, The Millrose Games at Madison Square Garden, Old Timers Baseball Game, US Tennis Open in Forest Hills and the US Tennis Open in Flushing, The Liberty Bowl in Nashville, Tennis Championship in Amelia Island, Fla., and the WTA Championships in California. The company had been sold to Octagon and she continued working for them for about 15 years. Although she worked on other events such as the Gravity Games, her focus was the tennis tournament in Florida. She spent two to three months a year in Florida, setting up the event.

She needed something to do in retirement, so she got permission from Fr. Harrington and proceeded to scrap and paint the fence at the church/rectory and school. After that she applied to Mount

Sinai Queens for a volunteer position. She was accepted and worked in the nursing department. On March 1, 2010, she received the Hospital Auxilian & Volunteer Achievement Award from the United Hospital Fund. In 2014 she received a Certificate of Appreciation for her work in the Nursing Department.

In 2009, she volunteered for Mike Bloomberg's Mayoral campaign. Every morning, she would go to the subway and give out flyers. She was given a Certification of Recognition for her efforts and an invitation to the inauguration.

At St. Joseph's, she has been a Lector, taught Religious Education for 6 years, makes the baskets for our raffles, oversees the decorating of our church for the various holidays and manages the food pantry. The food pantry has grown from about twenty-five families to currently seventy-five plus. We have moved from the basement of the rectory to a room in the convent. Fr. Vincent has provided us with ample storage space and has been supportive of our needs.

She is immensely proud of her son, Nick, has a wonderful dog in Dakini and two rescued cats.

Marlene was featured in Catholic News on 12/20/2023 in the Pulse of the Parish for all the work she does in decorating St. Joseph Church.





Service Award

Lily Daleo

The Service Award is for those parishioners who exemplify excellence in volunteering, and spearheading programs and projects.

Lily was born in the Bronx to Margaret & Paul Daleo. She grew up in Astoria and graduated from LIC High School. She is a true Astoria native living there her entire life.

Lily worked for Burberry for 30 years and she retired from there 9 years ago. Enjoying time at the Gian Piero Bakery after work, she became friends with Pat Freeman, Alice Freeman, and Pat Avitable. All three encouraged her to get more involved with St. Joseph Church. Lily started helping at the Rosary Meetings. Monsignor Ryan then asked her to become an Usher, which she still does 20 years later. Getting involved with the St. Joseph Academy, Lily volunteered to help with Religious Education by being a door monitor and has done this role as well for ten years. ASTORIA — Parishioners of St. Joseph Church in Astoria like to joke that they can set their watches by Father Edward Cassar, a kindly retired priest in residence at their parish. He's that precise. Every morning at 8 a.m. sharp, Father Cassar opens the church's adoration chapel and exposes the Blessed Sacrament so that the faithful can have a closer, deeper connection to Jesus Christ. Twelve hours later, exactly at 8 p.m., he returns to the chapel to retrieve the Blessed Sacrament, offers Benediction, and closes the chapel for the night. "I have a routine," he said. And during those inbetween hours, he often visits the chapel to pray and be there in case parishioners want to talk to him about their troubles. For Father Cassar, his daily devotion to the Blessed Sacrament is his way of trying to bring people closer to the Lord. "Your life is better if you let Him in," he explained. Parishioners like Matthew Gallagher appreciate the chapel and admire how Father Cassar takes care of it. "It's nice to know that the chapel is open seven days a week and that you can stop in to say a prayer. And Father Cassar is there every day," he said. On some mornings, there are people waiting for Father Cassar when he arrives to open the chapel.

Father Vincent Chirichella, pastor of St. Joseph Church, said Father Cassar is setting a great example for others. "And at a time like this,

when we are in the middle of a big Eucharistic Revival, what he's doing is important," he added. Father Vincent Chirichella pastor of St. Joseph's Church says Father Edward Cassar "holds his own Holy Hour" in the chapel each day. The nation's Catholics are currently in the midst of a three-year National Eucharistic Revival that was launched by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops in 2022. Dioceses across the nation were asked to organize their own Eucharistic Revival celebrations. The Diocese of Brooklyn's revival, which was originally scheduled to take place in October, will take place in the spring. The National Eucharistic Revival will culminate in 2024 with the National Eucharistic Congress, which will take place July 17-21 in Indianapolis. The idea is to promote a main tenet of the faith — that Jesus Christ is truly present in the Eucharist and that Communion isn't merely symbolic.

According to a 2019 survey by the Pew Research Center, only 31% of U.S. Catholics believe that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist. Father Cassar, who was ordained 54 years ago in his native Malta, has always had a devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, even as a child. "It's been a part of my life for a long time," he said. As a young man, he watched Archbishop Fulton Sheen on television talking about the importance of the Blessed Sacrament, and it left a big impression on him. Father Cassar carried that devotion with him through his various priestly assignments — vocations that took him to several countries around the world, including Australia and Ethiopia. He brought it with him when he arrived in the U.S. in 1972 to serve in the Diocese of Brooklyn. After serving at various parishes over the years, he retired a few years ago and arrived at St. Joseph Church two years ago — the same time Father Chirichella, with whom he had served at Our Lady of Grace Church in Gravesend, was assigned there. The chapel, which had been dormant and was reopened by Father Chirichella shortly after he got to St. Joseph, provides an important sanctuary for the faithful, Father Cassar said "It gives people a chance for a little one-to-one time with Jesus, "It's like Jesus talking to the woman at the well," he explained, referring to the famous passage from the Gospel of St. John.



St. Joseph Prayer

Joseph, by the work of your hands and the sweat of your brow, you supported Jesus and Mary, and had the Son of God as your fellow worker.

Teach me to work as you did, with patience and perseverance, for God and for those whom God has given me to support.

Teach me to see in my fellow workers the Christ who desires to be in them, that I may always be charitable and forbearing towards all.

Grant me to look upon work with the eyes of faith, so that I shall recognize in it my share in God's own creative activity and in Christ's work of our redemption, and so take pride in it.

When it is pleasant and productive, remind me to give thanks to God for it. And when it is burdensome, teach me to offer it to God, in reparation for my sins and the sins of the world.







REV. EDWARD A. CASSAR, RETIRED PRIEST, IN RESIDENCE



Fr. Edward was born in the island of Malta. While Malta has its own language and culture, it resembles the Italian culture very much. After Fr. Cassar finished High School, he attended St. Liberta College for Philosophy and then completed four years at St Laurence of Brindisi Seminary for Theology. Fr. Cassar was ordained a priest for the Capuchin Franciscan Order in Malta on March 22, 1969.

Immediately after his priestly ordination, he was sent to the Gregorian University in Rome for a post graduate course in Pastoral Theology and Missionology. Two months after Fr. Cassar returned to Malta from Rome to volunteer as a Missionary in Ethiopia, Africa where he was stationed in Addis Ababa and the Mission Station of Gigija. Fr. Cassar came to the US in 1972 to attend the New York Medical and Dental Assistants on a scholarship and graduated as a Medical Laboratory Technician. He has been in the Brooklyn Diocese for 50 years. For 17 years he worked in two parishes in Queens. He speaks English, Maltese, and Italian. Fr Cassar is passionate in being a priest for people.





FR. BILL FARRUGIA, RETIRED PRIEST

Father Bill attended Cathedral College, Brooklyn, NY; Niagara University, NY (BA); Our Lady of Angels Seminary, Albany, NY (Ordained in 1963); Webster University, St. Louis, MO (MA), and the United States Air Force's Air Command and Staff College, Montgomery, AL.

Father Bill has been ordained 61 years, during which he has served as a parish priest at St. Gabriel the Archangel, Brooklyn, NY; Incarnation Church, Queens Village, NY; high school guidance counselor at Monsignor McClancy High School from 2001-2010 and Air Force chaplain for 25 years, retiring as a Colonel in 1993. 


REVEREND JEAN LAGUERRE, IN RESIDENCE



Our beloved St. Joseph Parish dates back to 1879 when the first church was erected as a mission of St. Mary, Help of Christians, in Winfield. The parish buildings, circa 1907, included a convent, a new church, and a rectory – all along 30th Avenue. The current rectory was built in 1928 and the current convent building in 1938.

In the 1890's the Parish School was opened.

In the 1920's the new parishes of Precious Blood, Immaculate Conception, and St. Francis opened.

In the 1980's, the Food Pantry opened.

In 1950 & 1990, there were major renovation projects completed.

Our sincere thank you to the 11 Pastors who served from its inception, guided by God, to enhance and preserve our Parish and build a strong community grounded on Faith.

Fr. Vincent Chirichella became the 12th Pastor of St. Joseph RC Church. The following is a recap of our milestones under his leadership and direction:

- Formation of 6 New Groups & Youth Ministry

St. Therese of Lisieux

Born: January 2nd, 1873 Died: September 30th, 1897 Feast Day: October 1st Third woman to be named Doctor of the Church. St. Therese of Lisieux believed and taught us to see the value and holiness in little actions that may seem mundane or meaningless. These are not nuisances or interferences with life - but rather are "our" life! We are called to do it with holiness, embracing it as our work or service to others. We can find joy and God in even the smallest action. The little things are the big things and we can find holiness in the work in front of us. St. Therese's idea of practicing small acts with great love is a path that anyone can follow regardless of their circumstances in life. This is the little way that St. Thérèse has become well known. St. Teresa of Avila was a woman "for others."

Though a contemplative, she spent a good deal of her time and energy working to

reform herself and the Carmelites. She founded over a half-dozen new monasteries. She traveled, wrote and fought always to reform. In herself, in her prayer and in her life, in her efforts to reform, in all the people she touched. She lived out her "unconditional love for the Church" by serving and defending it in the face of division and conflicts. St Teresa was a woman for others, a woman who inspired! St. Therese of Lisieux and St. Teresa of Avila; though similar, having the same name, being both Carmelites, being both Doctors of the Church and having their Feast Day in October, had two very different ways to serve God. Each found their own unique way to serve Him. It is important for us to understand that Saints were ordinary people just as we are. There is no set rule on how we serve Him, Simply, that we do in our own unique way, using the gifts that our Lord gave us.
